Clyde Riggs Elementary is committed to frequent two-way communication with families about student learning.

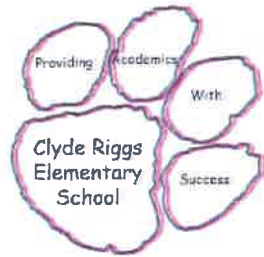
